This vast sand mass will leave you pondering.... the true Kalahari. "Shoot" lion with your camera and watch out for the Hyena at the camp! Our adventure takes us from Zeerust past the small town of Bray, where we will leave the tar for some time. After deflating tyres we will start the fun. Our campsite is rustic, unfenced, and do not have electricity or running water. We will follow the Boso 4x4 trail to Nossob and then North on the Polentswa Trail through Kaa and into the KD12 Wildlife management area to our end destination at Kang, Botswana. Enroute we will wildcamp on isolated pans, visit the Northern section of the Kagalagadi Transfontier Park and soak-up the dreams of Mabuasehube. This is as wild as you can get. Truly one of the last wilderness adventures!
