This ADVENTURE takes us to the lesser known wilderness areas of Namibia and Zambia. We first visit Khaudum NP in Namibia. Khaudum National Park is an isolated Nature Reserve situated in the Kalahari Desert at the west of the Caprivi Strip in northeast of Namibia. It is a very remote and inaccessible reserve but is home to some magnificent animals such as the lion and the hyena.

Then into Zambia to explore Liuwa plains (Barotse Flats). This remote park in the far west is pristine wilderness, which, to the ardent bush-lover, is its biggest attraction, and the rewards are great indeed. The game is spread out across the plains and takes some driving around to find, but to come upon a vast herd of blue wildebeest, a prowling wild dog, or a pride of dozing lions in this forgotten piece of Africa is especially fitting because of its completely natural and uncommercialised state.

Then Kafue National Park, which covers a massive area in western Zambia. It's known for its abundant wildlife and the Kafue River, running north to south through the park. An amazing experience.
