This vast sand mass will leave you pondering.... the true Kalahari. "Shoot" lion with your camera and watch out for the Hyena at the camp! Our adventure takes us from Zeerust along the A2 Trans Kalahari Highway a little village Kokostha, where we will leave the tar for some time. After deflating tyres, we start the fun. Our campsite is rustic, unfenced, and do not have electricity or running water. We spend 4 nights in Mabuasehube from where we venture further into the wilderness visiting Swartpan and Kaa Sections. We end the tour at Kalahari rest outside Kang on our way home. This is as wild as you can get. Truly one of the last wilderness adventures!
