This adventure is a combination of the wildebeest migration in Liuwa Plains and the migration of the “Flying Foxes” or straw-colored fruit bats in Kasanka National Park. One of Africa’s greatest wildlife spectacles, if not the world. The wildebeest migration in Liuwa Plain National Park known to be Africa’s second largest wildebeest migration.

November and December are prime months to visit with stunning skies and flower blooms.

We venture into the heart of Zambia and witness one of nature’s greatest migration of mammals on earth – 8-10 million straw colored fruit bats migrate to Mushitu’s swamp forest in northernmost Kasanka. This natural phenomenon takes place every year between October and December.

We visit Lake Kariba and its splendor and enjoy a sunset cruise on the Chobe River before we head back home.
